## PRESCHOOL TEACHER (SPECIAL DAY CLASS)

## **Brief Description of Position**

The Preschool SDC teacher works under the immediate supervision of the Director of Special Education and Student Services. The Preschool SDC teacher will help plan, implement, and coordinate a pre-school program serving 3-5 year old children with mild delays in learning. The program includes small group and individual instruction.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Shall contact parents regarding referrals and obtain consent for educational assessments.
- Shall perform appropriate assessments and prepare written reports.
- Shall coordinate Individual Education Plan meetings, contribute information necessary to develop the student's IEP, and monitor the IEP.
- Shall provide parent education and training to provide parent techniques and strategies to work with their child at home..
- Shall assist in the transition of students into the pre-school program as well as students leaving the program, including transitioning to kindergarten.
- Shall coordinate services with other private and public agencies.
- Shall provide data as requested to evaluate the effectiveness of the instructional program.
- Provide the necessary data regarding pupil count information.
