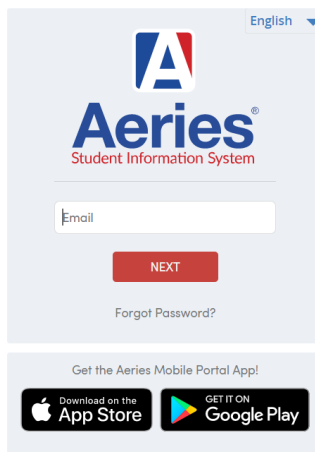


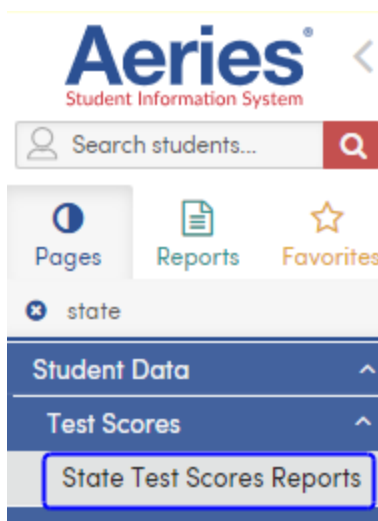
How To Access State Electronic Test Scores in Aeries

Scores are available to all parents who have a parent portal account. State Electronic Test Scores Reports page can be found in the navigation under Student Data | Test Scores or by typing State in the filter. It is available in both the District and School levels.
