- At EV Cain, Principal Mabery, in collaboration with CBO Leslie, has made significant strides in selecting
 playground structures tailored for our elementary and TK/K students. This initiative, funded through
 restricted resources, not the general fund, reflects our dedication to creating vibrant and engaging
 learning spaces for our youngest learners.
- The finalization of the bell schedule is underway.
- We are also thrilled to partner with Soccer Stars, an initiative that underscores our commitment to fostering physical health and teamwork among our students
- Lastly, the AUSD administration and Board are working diligently with our certificated staff members to conclude negotiations, aiming to solidify the foundation for a successful TK-8 transformation.
